

Military License Plate Application

Use this form to apply for a special military or armed forces license plate. To personalize your plate, use form TD-420-077, Personalized License Plate Application. For fee information, contact a vehicle licensing office or visit dol.wa.gov. For additional military or veteran's information, contact the Washington Department of Veteran's Affairs at 1-800-827-1000.

- Fill in the registered owner and vehicle information and check the box for the type of vehicle plate in section 1.
- Complete:
 - Section 2 if you are applying for a special military license plate. (Not available as trailer plates.)
 - Check the box for the special military license plate you are applying for.
 - Sign and date the application.
 - Section 3 if you are applying for an Armed Forces Collection license plate.
 - Check the box for the Armed Forces license plate you are applying for.
 - Check the box for the decal that you want for the Armed Forces license plate.
 - Check the box for the eligibility you are declaring.
 - Sign and date the declaration.
- Take or mail this completed application, any required supporting documentation from Washington State Department of Veteran Affairs, and fees to any vehicle licensing office.
